Summary

Belgium regularly reports hate crime data to ODIHR. Recent initiatives to improve hate crime identification, recording and data collection have been implemented through ODIHR's Information Against Hate Crimes Toolkit (INFAHCT) programme. In particular, Belgium has implemented the programme's recommendations on the operational practice of police, prosecutors, and equality bodies.

Anti-Semitic hate crime

Official figures record three assaults against four Jewish people, in a neighbourhood primarily inhabited by Orthodox Jews.



Anti-LGBTI hate crime

Belgium reported an incident in which two men were assaulted by five individuals in an attack allegedly motivated by homophobia.



Disability hate crime

Belgium reported the abuse and mistreatment of a man with mental disabilities. The alleged perpetrators were arrested and the case is under investigation.
