Summary

France regularly reports hate crime data to ODIHR. Since 2012, DILCRAH has served as an inter-ministerial body and platform for co-operation to address hate crime, including through research and financial support to civil society organizations (CSOs). DILCRAH has worked with CSOs to train police and create a network of specialized investigators on hate crime. The Central Office for Combating Crimes against Humanity and Hate Crimes (OCLCH) is an inter-agency body composed of police officers and gendarmes that is mandated to expedite hate crime investigations and monitor and analyse relevant developments. Hate crime data are regularly published by the National Institution for Human Rights. France conducts regular surveys on hate crime victimization to measure unreported hate crimes.

ODIHR's Key Observation

ODIHR observes that France has met most OSCE commitments on hate crime data collection and reporting. ODIHR further observes that data on certain OSCE-mandated bias motivations have not been reported.

Anti-Semitic hate crime

Official data recorded 851 anti-Semitic hate crimes, including 241 of violent nature, and 610 of threatening character.

Racist and xenophobic hate crime

Official data recorded 678 racist hate crimes, including 101 of violent nature, and 577 of threatening character.



Anti-Muslim hate crime

Official data recorded 133 anti-Muslim hate crimes, including 55 of violent nature, and 78 of threatening character.

Physical assault

The category "threats and threatening behaviour" consists of verbal insults, remarks or threatening gestures, graffiti or intimidating demonstrations.

The category "physical assault" consists of physical attacks on persons, violent attacks against property, including arson, cases of harassment and other violence.
