### ODIHR's Key Observation

ODIHR observes that Andorra did not report information and statistics on hate crimes to ODIHR for the 2024 Hate Crime Report. In addition, ODIHR observes that Andorra would benefit from raising awareness among and building the capacity of law enforcement and criminal justice officials to address hate crimes.

# Official Data

Further 11 cases of discrimination and insult were reported by the police, but were not included as they fall outside the OSCE definition of hate crime. Data on the application of the aggravating circumstance provision (Article 30.6) is not collected.
