## Police data by bias motivation

### Racist and xenophobic hate crime

In December 2011 two men were charged for hate crime offences, dating back to 2008. The crimes included setting a sleeping Filipino man on fire in Vancouver in October 2009, seriously physically assaulting a black man, and three counts of assault against an aboriginal woman in 2010.

### Anti-LGBTI hate crime

Official figures record 240 hate crimes motivated by bias against sexual orientation.

### Anti-Semitic hate crime

The **Canadian Parliamentary Coalition to Combat Anti-Semitism** published its final report, which recommended introducing national standards relating to hate crime for police services across the country and to report and analyse data, including a breakdown of crimes by bias motivation, as part of the annual *Uniform Crime Reporting Survey*.

In connection with the above, the **Canadian Government** signed the *Ottawa Protocol on Combating Antisemitism*, which calls for leaders of faith groups to combat hatred and discrimination, including anti-Semitism; for governments to reaffirm and implement the United Nations 1948 Genocide Convention; for the establishment of an international task force to identify and monitor hate on the Internet; and for the development of a comprehensive system to record all hate crimes.

### Hate crime against Christians and members of other religions

Official figures record 89 anti-religion hate crimes, not including incidents motivated by an anti-Jewish or anti-Muslim bias.
