ODIHR observes that the law enforcement agencies of Kazakhstan have not recorded the bias motivations of hate crimes.

# Official Data

A further 128 incidents of hate speech were reported but not included. The reported sentencing figure includes incidents that fall outside of the OSCE's definition of hate crime.

## National Developments

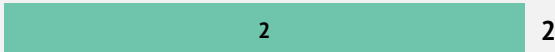
