Latvia last reported hate crime data to ODIHR for the 2016 Hate Crime Report. Latvia implemented ODIHR's Training Against Hate Crime for Law Enforcement (TAHCLE) programme in 2015.

ODIHR's Key Observation

ODIHR observes that Latvia has not reported on hate crimes separately from cases of hate speech.



Official Data

Reported police and prosecution figures consist of incitement of hatred cases, some of which may have involved violence or threats.
