ODIHR's Key Observation

ODIHR recognizes Liechtenstein's efforts to report hate crime to ODIHR. However, based on the available information, it observes that Liechtenstein does not collect data and statistics on hate crimes. In addition, ODIHR observes that Liechtenstein would benefit from raising awareness among and building the capacity of criminal justice officials to address hate crime.

Official Data

The National Police only publishes data on cases of discrimination according § 283 Criminal Code. The numbers above therefore present cases that fall outside the OSCE's definition of hate crime. Liechtenstein does not record the bias motivations of crime, and there are therefore no statistics on hate crime.
