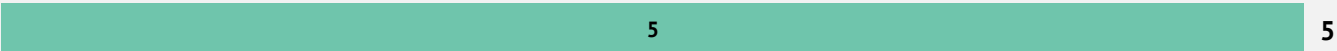
No hate crimes were registered by police. Sentencing judgments were reported in hate speech cases.
